Last week at the Middle East Forum on Quality Improvement in Healthcare, leaders of the [Hamad Medical Corporation \(HMC\)](#) in Doha, Qatar, announced that the IHI Open School courses would be used for training within the organization. IHI Open School Operations Director, Carly Strang, helped launch the initiative by explaining how the courses will help staff to continue learning about the fundamentals of improvement and safety beyond the conference.
