A Quality Movement in Qatar

In a little more than two months, since the Middle East Forum on Quality Improvement, more than 2,500 staff members at the Hamad Medical Corporation (HMC) in Qatar have completed nearly 20,000 IHI Open School courses. Nearly 500 of those staff members have earned their Basic Certificate, completing 16 core courses in improvement capability; patient safety; leadership; person- and family-centered care; and quality, cost, and value.

"I'm very surprised," says Nasser Al Naimi, Executive Director of the Center for Healthcare Improvement at HMC. "Even now, as we're in Ramadan, the Islamic month of fasting, with staff fasting during the day and working reduced hours, the rate of completing courses is amazing. I'm really amazed and delighted at the dedication with which our staff have pursued this wonderful learning opportunity."



More than 20,000 employees work at HMC, which has provided unique opportunities and challenges for rolling out the educational initiative. HMC is one of more than 450 organizations that are using the online

What We're Reading: "Slow Ideas" by Atul Gawande



A new article by Atul Gawande investigates two puzzling questions, which are familiar to any student interested in quality improvement. Why do some innovations spread quickly, and how can we speed the ones that don't?

In the 19th century, Gawande explains in *The New Yorker*, surgeons faced two significant obstacles to their mission: the pain of surgery, and the prevalence of post-surgical infection. Thanks to scientific innovation, solutions emerged for both. One (anesthesia) offered readily apparent benefits to all, and the other (antiseptics)

worked invisibly, with some prerequisite discomfort for the surgeon. You can guess which good idea saw immediate, widespread adoption -- and which went ignored for years.
