The Ohio State University Chapter took its quality improvement skills to the front lines, working with hospital leadership on an improvement project to increase hand hygiene compliance. As part of a two-year collaborative led by the Ohio Hospital Association and the Central Ohio Hospital Council, the Chapter helped raise compliance rates from 47% to 86%. In our

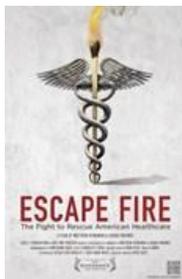
