

## Ask Me 3 Complimentary Materials: Terms and Conditions for Use

The Institute for Healthcare Improvement/National Patient Safety Foundation (IHI/NPSF) encourage use of Ask Me 3® materials and resources to help patients become more active members of their health care team, and provide a critical platform to improve communications between patients, families, and health care professionals.

- Users understand that use of these materials does not indicate IHI endorsement.
- Users will adhere to the highest standards of professionalism in the use and distribution of the Ask Me 3 materials.
- Materials are not intended for commercial use or to facilitate any kind of sale and should not appear on pages selling products or services.
